SERMON NOTES

All Saints Sunday, November 3, 2024 – Pastor Kischnick

THEME: "Not Lost, Just Away" **TEXT**: Revelation 7:9-17

INTRO. 14 names > 1/10,000 of "144,000" = the full measure of the Saints w/ white robes. Memories > sorrow, yes, BUT today is a day of joy and victory: All Saints Sunday, day we celebrate the victory – those who died in Christ. Live w/Him, safe & HOME.

TRADITION: 11/01 – All Saints, 11/02 – All Souls. "Saints" – more good works than sins. We believe all in Christ are "Saints" so today we thank God they are "Not Lost, Just Away."

I. WHO ARE THEY?

<u>ILLUST</u>. Civil War importance of flags/guidons: in confusion of battle need to know "Who are those people?"

- A. The Elder: "These are they who..."
 - 1. White robes made clean in the blood of the Lamb.
 - 2. Palm branches to symbolize VICTORY.
 - 3. Have come out of the GREAT TRIBULATION = Life in this world.
- B. Frome every nation, tribe, people, and language.
- C. Live before God and "under his tent".
- D. The Lamb will continue to be their Shepherd.

II. THEY ARE NOT LOST

<u>ILLUST</u>. "A Christmas Story" Ralphie has big fight. Mom washes face, to bed. In kitchen she hears whimper. Smiles. Knows Randy there. Not lost.

- A. Our "dead in Christ" are not LOST.
 - 1. We know where they are and we'll see them again.
 - 2. I Thess.4 "The Lord will bring WITH JESUS...the dead in Christ will rise FIRST."
- B. Separated from us ONLY by time.
- C. "The Communion of Saints" we are eternally connected to the Saints, living AND departed. We worship God TOGETHER.

III. THEREFORE, LIFT UP YOUR HEARTS!

- A. "See what great love the Father has lavished on us..."
 - 1. Children of God 2. "We shall see Him as He really is..."
- B. Perhaps the Best Promise in Scripture: "And He will wipe away EVERY TEAR from their eyes."

<u>CLOSE</u>: Dan & family moved – Bullitt Co. (45 min.) to Ithaca (11 hrs.). We know where they are. See them at Christmas, we hope. Better promise from God: those at home with the Lord – not <u>IF</u> but <u>WHEN</u> we see them again. <u>PROMISE OF GOD</u> in Christ Jesus, our Savior. "Not Lost, Just Away"
