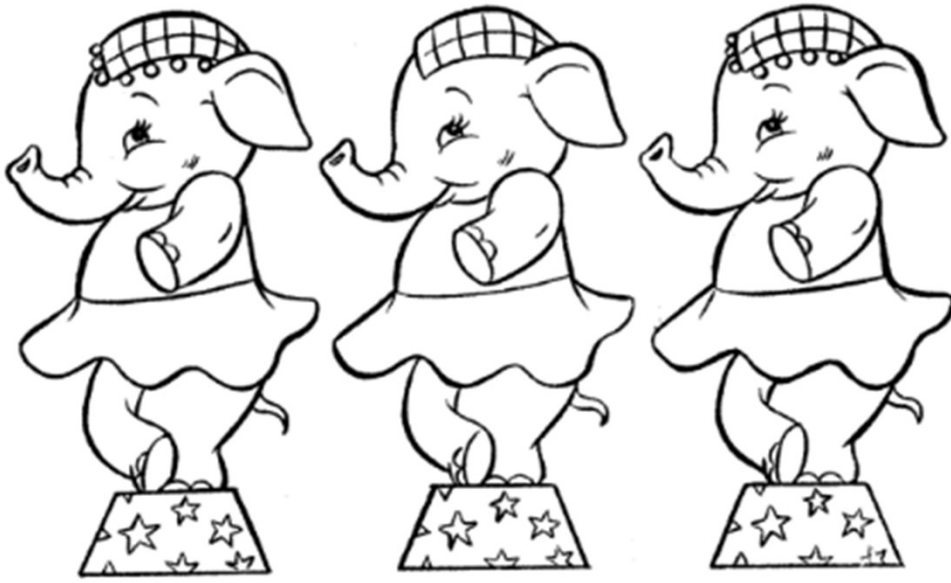


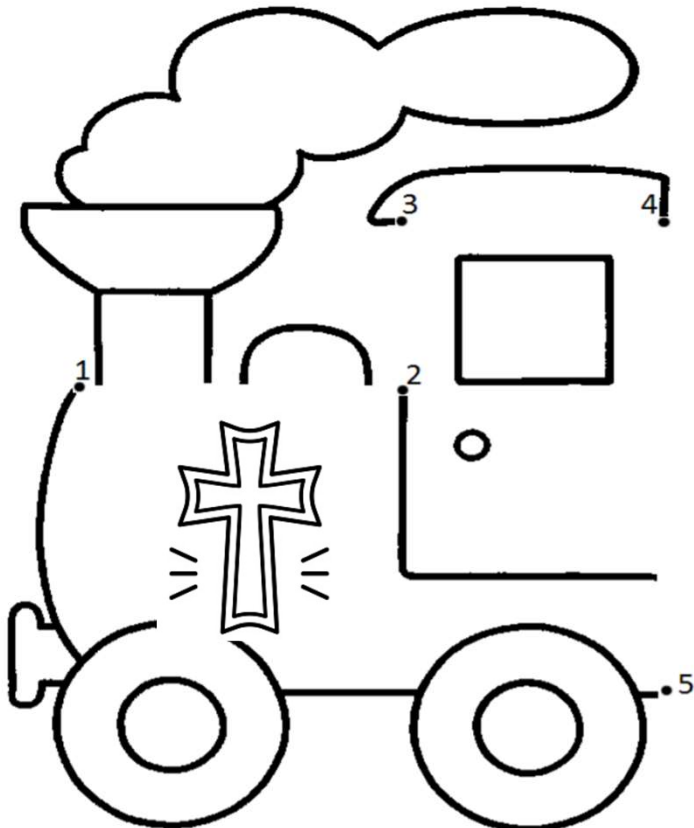

"Help us to be ready to welcome You, O God!"

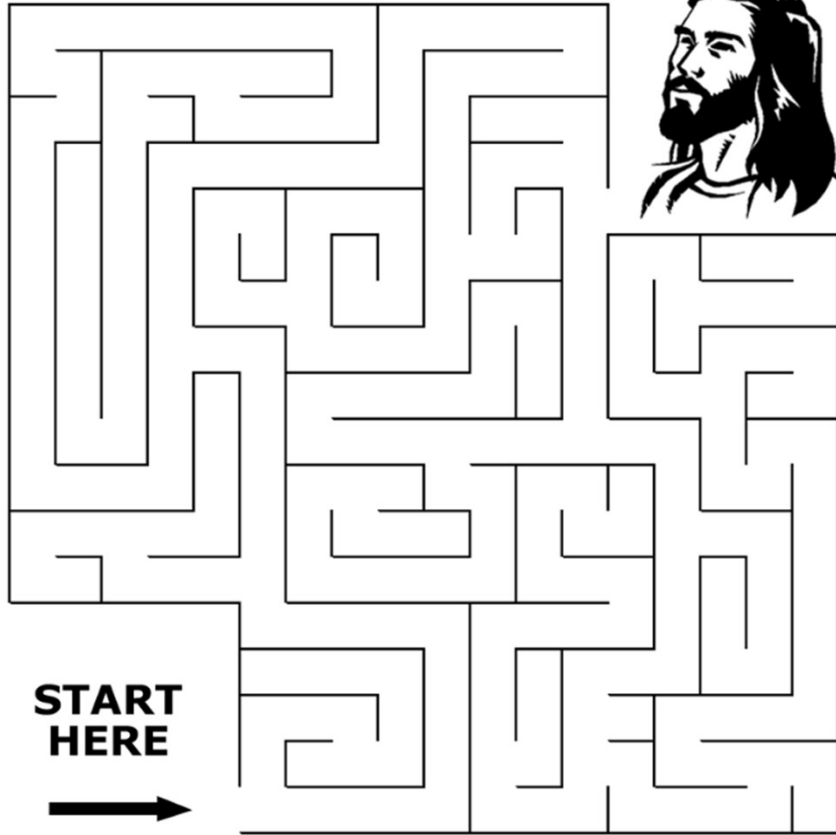
