

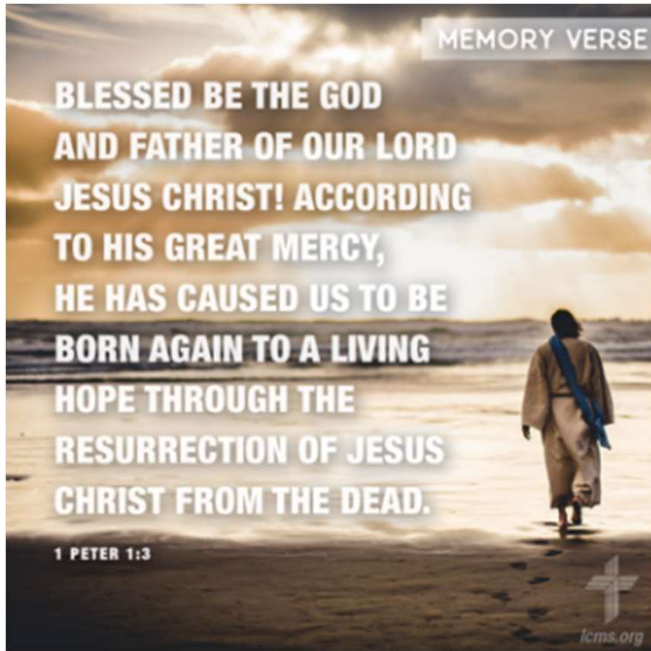

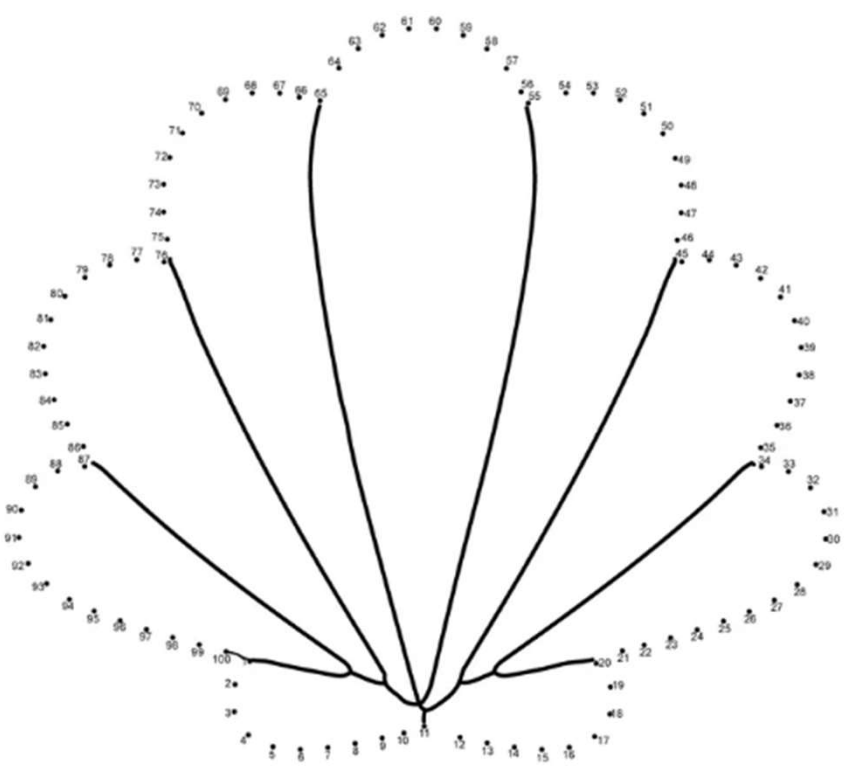

.John 2:1-11

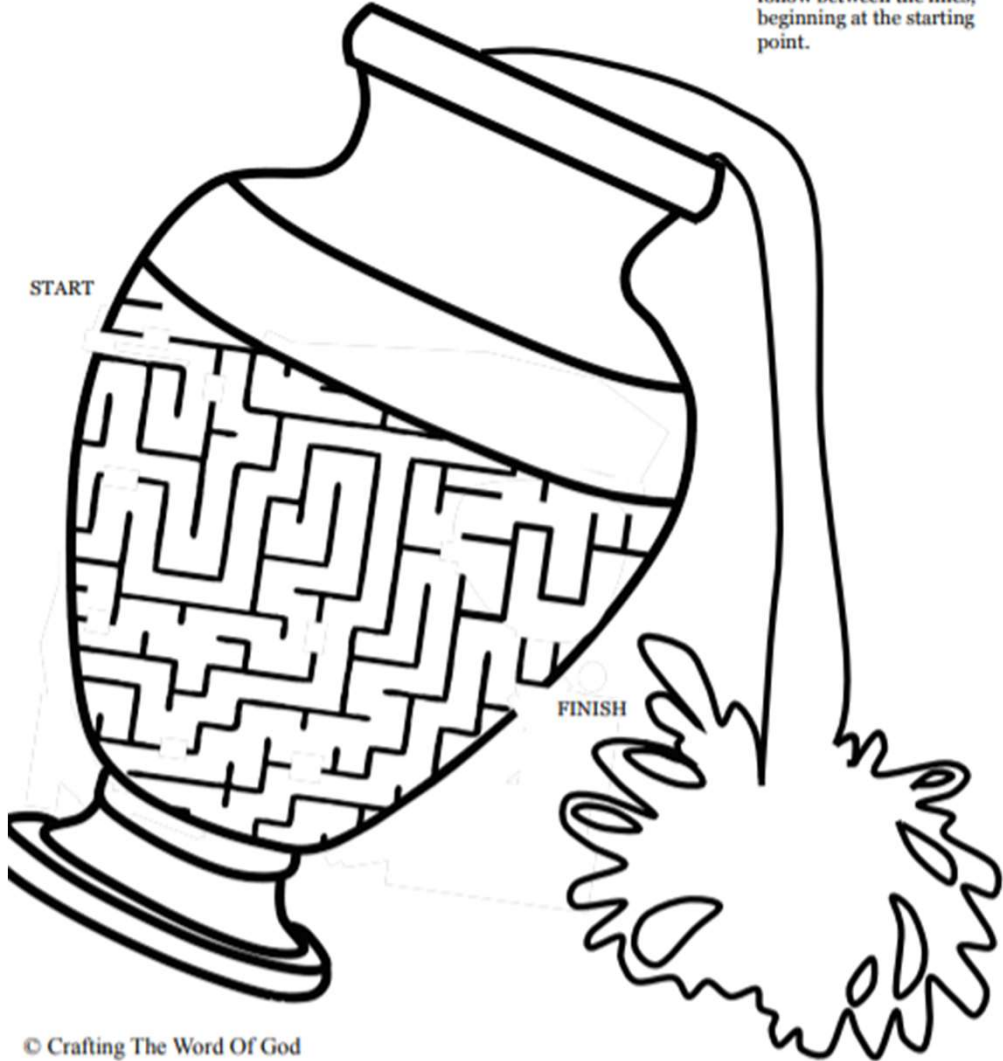
