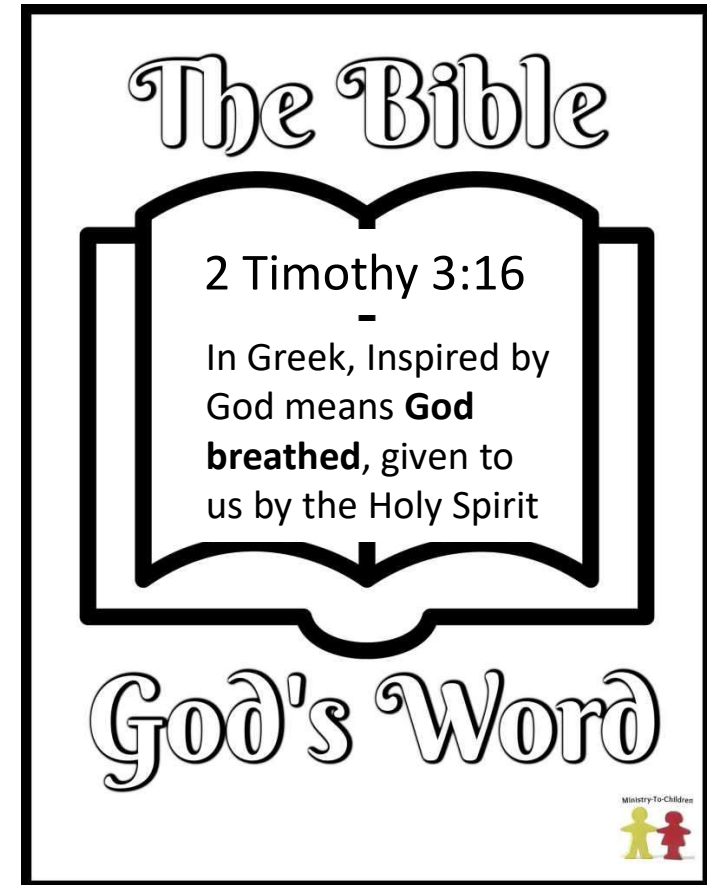

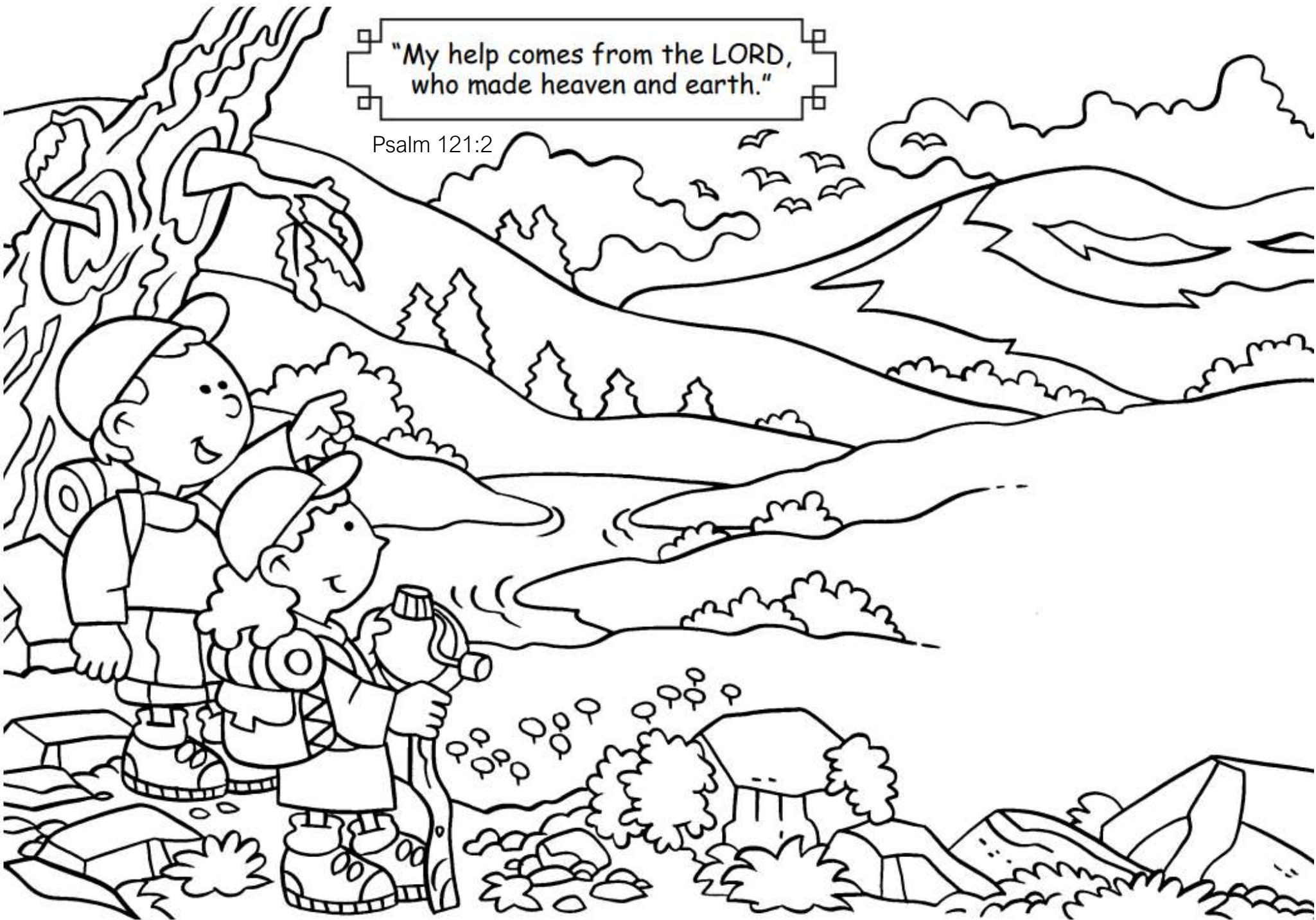

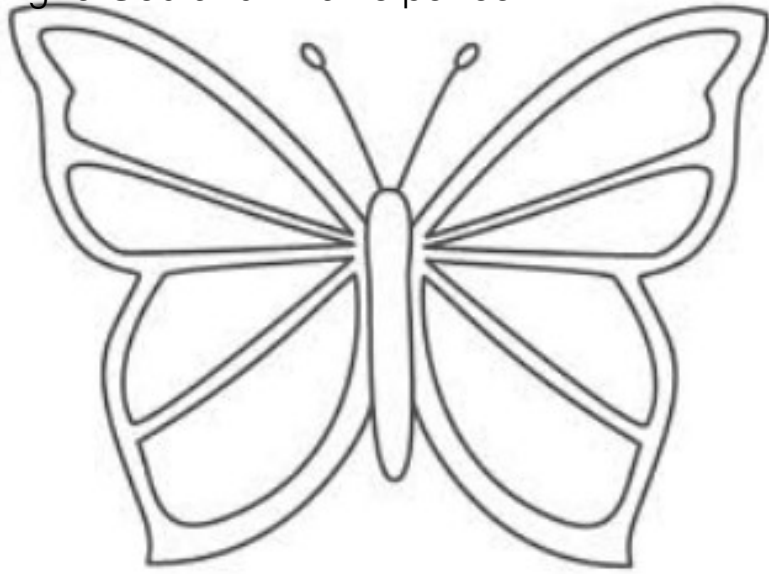
"My help comes from the LORD,

Our prayers travel from our mouths to God's ear.

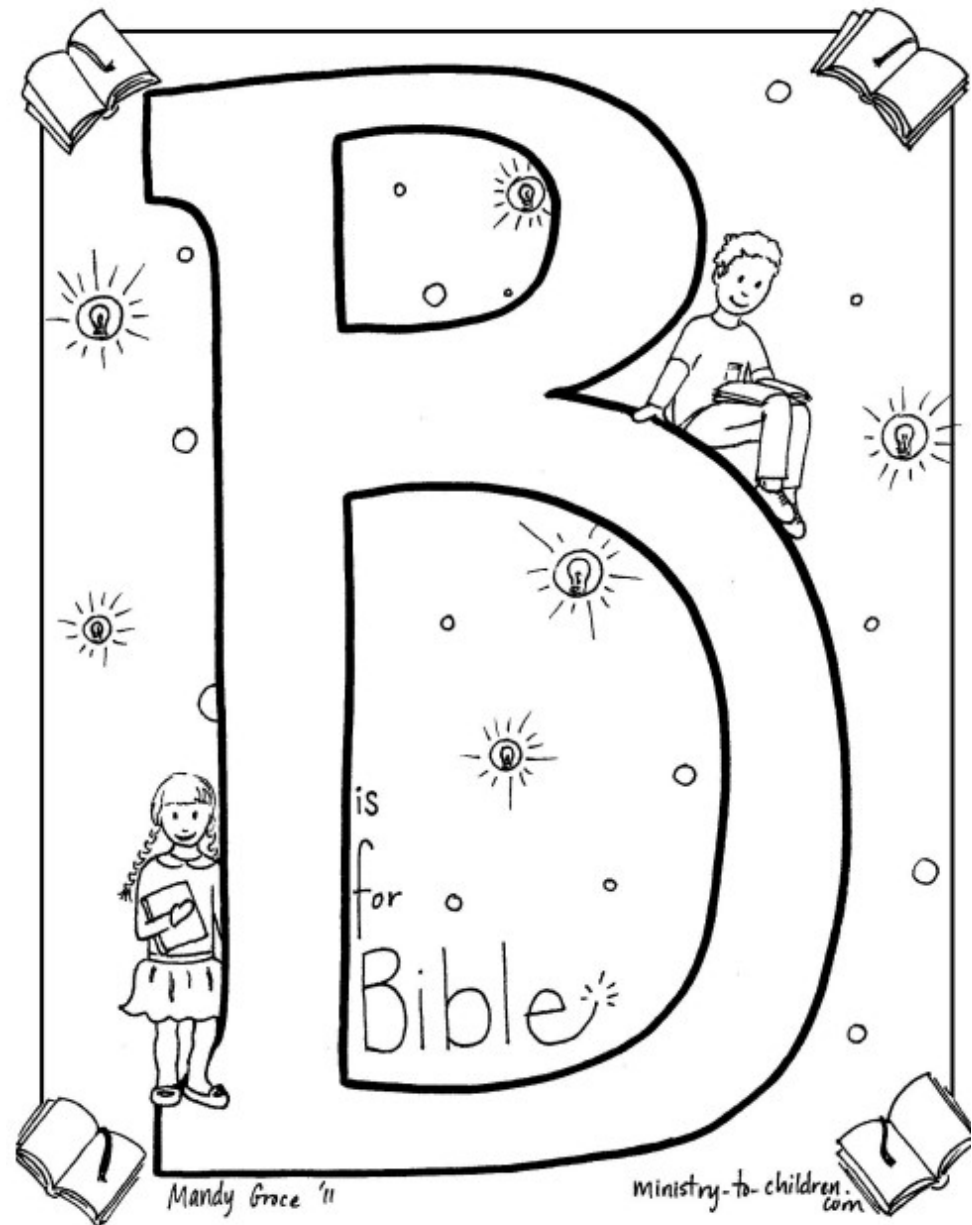
